Acacia is a fast growing species, originating from Australia. It's lumber is commonly used in the furniture industry, as well as for flooring and pallet manufacturing. MTP has got it's own resource of certified acacia plantations, which we are processing into sawn lumber. Our timber is delivered air dried, with a moisture content of around 18%.

We produce according to order, in roughly the following dimensions:

• Thicknesses: 18-90 mm

Widths: 50-90 mm

· Lengths: 600-2,000 mm

Our main grade is a "Natural Feauture Grade". This is a type of medium feature grade that is perfect for those who appreciate unique characteristics. It showcases a variety of interesting features such as knots and a broader spectrum of color variations compared to the superior grades.
